



The Architecture of an Enterprise

Architecture

A formal description of a system, or a detailed plan of the system at component level, to guide its implementation

(ISO/IEC 42010:2007).

The <u>structure of components</u>, their <u>inter-relationships</u>, and the <u>principles and guidelines</u> governing their <u>design</u> and evolution over time.

Enterprise

The highest level (typically) of description of an organization and typically covers all missions and functions.

An enterprise will often span multiple organizations.







Enterprise Architecture A definition

is the process of translating the business strategy and architecting the enterprise to ensure planning reliability, transparency and sustainability of IT investments to enable business success.



It includes both the process and the result.












Mapping of TOGAF <u>Architecture Development Methodology</u> with QualiWare Lifecycle Manager (QLM)












Example 1 Water Injection Project
