US Consolidated Reference Model (CRM)







Gartner Recommendations



Enterprise architects:

- Target mission areas to lead innovation, improve interoperability and enable digital government.
- Don't "sell" EA. Use EA processes to generate analysis that drives decisions, and keep the focus on the issues.
- Use diagnostic and actionable deliverables to resolve disconnects across policy, strategy and operational priorities.
- Proactively manage stakeholder concerns to ensure EA recommendations will be acted on.
